
Children

Diocesan Annual Income Survey

Each year the diocese asks us to complete an anonymous income survey. All that is required is for each regular attender aged 16 or over, those who come at least 12 times a year, to tick a box on the sheet that indicates their gross annual income. The sheets, pens and the sealed box are available at the back of church. If you would like to discuss this please speak to a warden. It is important that everyone completes a form even if they earn nothing, in fact, especially if they earn nothing. The more people that complete a form the more accurate is our data and consequently the more accurate is the amount of our Parish Share which is derived from this information. The survey runs from today until Sunday 23rd October.
