
Children

After a lot of effort and discussions the committee have presented their proposal to the PCC for the renewal of the Centenary Room. We will be sharing this briefly during the 10.00am service on Sunday 29th January. Details and drawings will be available at the back of church and members of the committee will be on hand to answer your questions. We wish to thank you all for your support especially the money you have donated towards the project. To date we have raised £7,321.94 since we started our appeal in September, This includes £432.39 from HMRC for donations which were submitted with Gift Aid. Donations continue to arrive and we will keep you regularly informed of the progress.
