
Children

Junior Church Needs You

From March we will have no Junior Church Leaders. We have 16 children in total who attend several times a year and some most weeks. It is a crucial ministry without which we will lose the children as a full adult service is not appropriate. I appreciate leading needs confidence and skill which I know some of you have from previous employment or experience in leading Junior Church in the past. We need ideally 3 leaders (+ assistants for safeguarding purposes) to each cover 1 Sunday of 3 a month term time only. We use pre prepared worksheets requiring minimal prep. There is normally a choice of an activity - craft, drama etc. which would require a bit more prep. If you want to find out more then have a word with me. There will be a meeting after Church on 12th Feb. Children's input to this meeting will be welcome. We will also discuss other roles older children might take on in church and as junior leaders. Please help if you can.

Bible Study Lent 2023 - Dust and Glory

This Lent we are all invited to explore how we can live well with the mess of everyday life.

"Dust and Glory encourages us to take a fresh look at the frustrations and failings that every day brings and, rather than pretending we can always avoid them, seek to learn from them and grow closer to God through them." Archbishops of Canterbury and York

The booklet 'Dust and Glory' is in hard copy (I have 20) or online in various forms or through the App. I would encourage us all to follow this series of 40 reflections, as individuals, as part of our Lenten discipline and to meditate on each day's reflection.

Study Groups: St Stephen's, All Saints & St James

In addition, if you want to explore your thoughts and feelings more then on Monday evenings 7pm we will meet in the Centenary Room. To facilitate this each person will need to keep a simple diary of thoughts/ actions for each day and also during the week. Each Session will last approximately an hour with some fellowship time afterwards with tea and bickies (other refreshments will be available. It will consist of:-

- Introduction led by the facilitator(15min)
- Open discussion about the Daily Reflections of the previous week. (30min)
- Prayer this may be quiet, Compline, Celtic etc. (15min)

6/3 What is failure?
13/3 Understanding Sin.
20/3 Sinning as Well as We Can?
27/3 Failure and the Church
3/4 Living Well with Failure (Following Holy Week Compline)
